
We appreciate your membership in OBEA and your passion in our shared mission to support the professional growth of business educators.

The annual OBEA Student Awards Luncheon was held on Saturday, September 30, 2017, at the Holiday Inn Select Airport Hotel in Toronto. This year, we had 54 award winners from 15 Contests. Their names and schools are posted at www.obea.ca. The Student Awards Luncheon was a memorable and celebratory afternoon for students, parents, family, and teachers. Our Keynote Speaker was Madison Post, who is the owner of Your Fired Ceramics in Richmond Hill. Her address entitled, "The Art of Business," with themes of working hard, perseverance, and passion resonated with all.

The OBEA Contests give Ontario Business Studies students an opportunity to use their competencies and skills, while being recognized for their commitment to academic excellence. The students' efforts from throughout the province were highly commendable. OBEA has a dedicated team of volunteer Contest Chairs who generously donate many hours of their time to designing Contests and evaluating students' work. Here are a few interesting points to note:



- With the exception of the Accounting Contests, all Contests now have up to five entries per school. This has changed from two entries per school.

- The online Accounting Contests, will run a practice session for students one week prior to the Contest. Visit the OBEA Website for dates. A special note of thanks to Al Samsa for completing another bank of 100 multiple-choice questions for both the Grade 11 and Grade 12 Accounting Contests, including the 20 practice questions for each level.

- All winning entries for each OBEA Contest will be verified to ensure that there is an active OBEA member in the school. Therefore, please ensure that your membership is active so that your students qualify. You can register a new or update an existing



membership online.

- Don't forget to check out the 2017-2018 Contest Handbook. Please review any Contest changes to avoid confusion for the students.

- OBEA encourages you to have your students participate in the many Contests available, and perhaps we will see you at the Awards Luncheon in the fall of 2018. If you have any questions, please contact the appropriate Contest Chair or the new Contest Coordinator.
